

Catch A Thief

- Make sure all boat equipment that can be carried away has boat's registration number hidden on it.
- If a thief sells an item at a pawn shop or salvage yard they must use a photo ID and record their address.
- Police can trace the item to your boat if you marked it with your boat's registration number, then contact you through the boat's registration records.

Stop A Thief

- Show a MWCD Ranger documentation that you inventoried your boat's equipment and marked the items with the boat's registration number.
- You will receive two decals to place on the boat windows that warns criminals:
